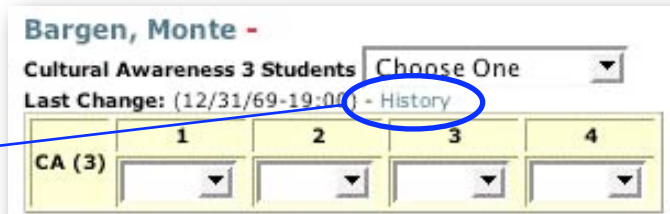

### Individual Student History

- 1) To get to the individual student area, select a group from your list.
- 2) Select a student from your list.
- 3) Then click the “History” text link.



### Systemwide History

- 1) To get to the systemwide history area, click the “History” text link from the main navigation menu.

Both of these links will open a similar page that looks something like the one on the right. The default view shows the last 10 changes, but you can change that to view more.
